## Paycheck Protection Program (PPP)

Effective January 15, 2021, the PPP loan portal is reopened to eligible lenders with \$1 billion or less in assets for First and Second Draw applications. Effective January 19, 2021, the portal is fully reopened to all participating PPP lenders to submit First and Second Draw loan applications to the SBA.
